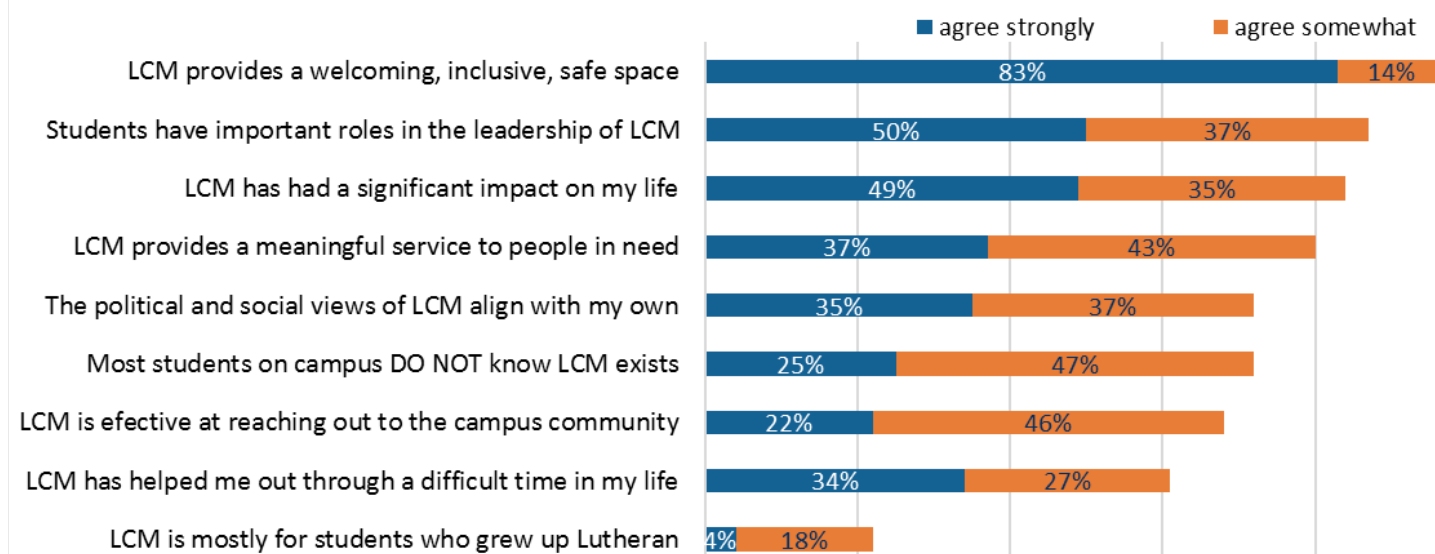

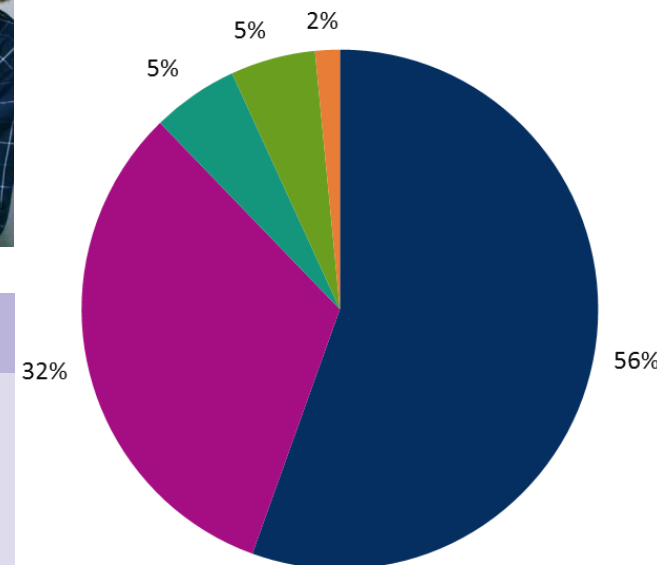
### Alumnus

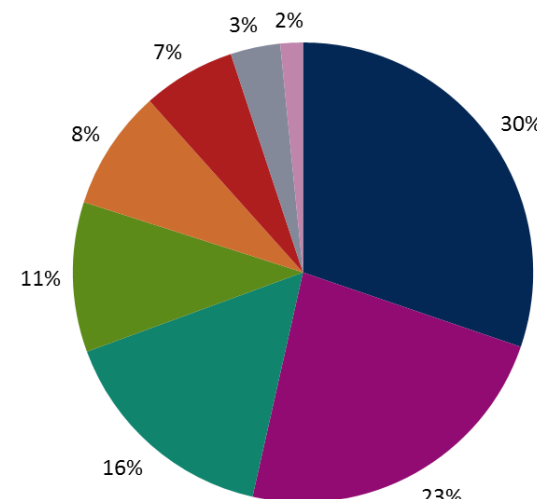
## LCMNU By the Numbers
